So your child can keep learning at home, we have the following systems:

1. Knowledge Organiser Folder: all students have a folder with a knowledge organiser for each subject which they use at the start and end of all lessons. You can support your child by asking to see the knowledge organiser, quizzing them on key information and encouraging them to use it when doing homework.
2. Google Classroom: Your child is now able to access home learning via Google Classroom. Teachers will post work regularly to help students develop independence and extend their knowledge. 3. Use GCSE Pod to revise key topics for each subject.
4. Use Hegarty Maths, as directed by your maths teacher.
5. Read! Books, magazines, blogs, revision guides. Try to spend at least 20 minutes per day reading something interesting.
